Special Education:

PSSA/Keystone Accommodations

Make sure you are checking the accommodations on the IEPs of the students you will administer these tests to. Discuss it with the casemanager if they are not in a small group and their IEP states small group.

Math PSSA:

Small group 1-5—all students have same test and they have ALL of it read aloud to them.

Small group 1-12- tests are spiraled, student may ask for it to be read aloud to them as needed

ELA PSSA: small group-same numbers as above but only the directions are read to them

PASA: The only concerns I have heard regarding this test is that the new cameras were not functioning properly. We will look into getting better cameras for next year.
