- The procedure for reporting building issues is to notify the custodian, he/she talks with principal e-mail works for communication. If it is deemed necessary a work order will be issued.
- The rodent problem is being addressed across the district. The process is that Ehrlich Pest Control is monitoring all buildings for any pest. They use the least invasive procedures first. Moving to more invasive procedures. For example, glue traps first to monitor and next snap traps based on count. Along with this, they work with district maintenance staff to close off areas where pests are entering.
- It seems that all concerns are being addressed or in the process of being addressed.
- Remember some services require preauthorization for Capital Blue. When in doubt call the number on the card.
- The Capital Blue Virtual Care is a fast easy way to "see" a doctor and is covered for most "visits" under our insurance.
- Please, remember births and marriages must be reported promptly. Failure to do so could result in denial of benefits. Remember, if any employee gets married, the spouse must purchase coverage from their employer if it is offered.
