The Chain of Command: (also refer to 1-5 of Reminders)

1. Building reps should receive concerns from membership.
2. Reps should discuss concerns with the building administration as a *cohesive group*.
 - This implies that reps should be communicating with each other.
 - building level issues include coverages, coverage pay, student concerns, referrals & consequences, building maintenance, parking lot concerns and classroom issues.
3. If the issue needs to be taken to the next level, **THEN** you would contact the building level officer.

- 1) When contacting an officer, please make sure you have all the information about the situation. We are always available to discuss the situation with you. Please having all the facts so that we can best help with the plan of action.
- 2) Please remember that reps should be holding at least one building meeting per month. Also, please attempt to hold one monthly meeting with your building administration to address building concerns.
- 3) It is the expectation of the association that building reps are sharing situational information that is happening to our members.
- 4) Sharing building situations and outcomes from rep to rep is not in violation of HIPPA. It is understood that reps will not pass on information to other members unless they are directly involved.
- 5) Please remember that members can request specific representation, but administration DOES NOT have to grant that request.
