As we struggle to create safe spaces throughout all of our campuses, it is imperative that we work the system that is in place. When you write a referral, you can check on the status by going into eSchools, Interventions, Classroom Issues, Issue List (2 icons left of the setting wheel icon) and look under the Issue Status column. If it still says "referred" after 48 hours, follow up with your AP. If you submitted a Conduct Referral (done for student you do not teach), you must ask the AP for the disposition. If you do not agree with the disciplinary action for any written referral, you need to have a conversation with the AP. I know it is one more thing on your overflowing plate, but this is how we make progress. It is best practice to write a referral in conjunction with all Incident Reports since Incident Reports do not have to be dealt with the same way as referral.
