1. Indicate the building.

3. Indicate the specific issue.
4. Indicate that you talked to administration - names and dates.
5. Timeline of events. With any actions take. For example, work order placed on (date). AC contractors looked at vent, however, was not fixed on (date).

Reading High School:

1. The Guidance Suite was cleared.
2. Room 111 is scheduled to be abated.
3. Rooms 151,155,157 to be checked. Also, 354 should be checked.
4. The welding incident was brought to the attention of the safety committee by multiple people. This also brought up that the staff is keeping our students safe, however, there needs to be more thought and oversight with construction in our school.
